changing hands with the small and medium farmers. They have been helplessly subjected to a abject living conditions, awaiting measures for reversal.

SPADE's interventions in the field agriculture have two major dimensions viz. to improve the economic status of the poor and marginalized farmers through introduction of improved agricultural practices and secondly to preserve soil fertility by adopting eco-friendly agricultural practices.

With a wide canopy of cultivations covering vegetable, dal, fishery, rice (through SRI), poultry & duckery, nutrition garden etc., the villagers are steadfastly coming out of their marginalised existance and making sure a better living for themselves. SPADE is influencing the community to cultivate improved rice varieties like black rice, aromatic rice through SRI methods and to produce early and late varieties of vegetables so that the farmers may enhance their income. The organisation also continues to play the role of a facilitator in providing hand holding and yield augmenting support to existing gardens and formation of new nutrition gardens as well. SPADE also provides capacity building inputs like use of SRI method, vermin-composting, preparation of other bio-fertilizers and bio pesticides. While SRI reduces the cost of agriculture, vermin-compost and other bio-fertilizers retain soil fertility, bio-pesticides have the proven potential to prevent ecological imbalance. Hence the inputs provided by SPADE make agricultural activities more sustainable and climate friendly.

SPADE is implementing Tata Power Community Development Trust's CSR project at Haldia wherein promoting sustainable agricultural practices is a priority. Total beneficiaries under this project have already crossed 400 households.

Finally, SPADE is readying to promote agriculture causing no harm to the climate. Towards this end, SPADE shall introduce user friendly quality vermin-compost, bio-pesticide to the farmers. Organistaion's future plan includes promotion of seed bank for assured the supply of quality seeds.
