- Provided hands-on training





- Basic accounting required for a running shop.





Thereafter provide 3 months shop support training through business facilitator to ensure smooth operation of shop. Also provide financial support for procuring machines.

- Packaging of bakery items



6. Post Training Engagement of the Trainees:

- 1. The skill training on five trades commenced on December 2018 and completed on April 2019 with 150 participants belonging to existing functional Self Help Groups in the Haldia Municipality.
- 2. After completion of the training programme, the municipality provided required infrastructure like equipments, land and building, furniture and fixtures etc. for paper cup plate making and Bakery and Confectionary Trainees. The trainees are now engaged in producing the items and selling their products in the Haldia Market. Depending upon the feedback of the markets they are also redesigning / introducing new products. For example the paper cup making unit have identified that cups of 100 ml has a greater demand in the market, so they are seeking support for procurement of new dies for producing.
- 3. On the other hand, trainees of cloth recycling, Apparel and paper up-cycling have submitted application for securing loans from the banks while some them have already initiated the project from their own and now earning to the tune of INR 700 per month from their respective trade.
- 4. We also organized a marketing event at Haldia municipality premises by displaying their products to have a practical marketing experience among the beneficiaries
- 5. Almost all the trainees participated in the exhibition cum sale their products under Haldia Utsav 2018 organized by Haldia Municipality.
- 6. Authorities of Haldia Municipality declared that attempts shall be made to provide credit support for all the beneficiaries so that they can promote their livelihood.
